This award was established to commemorate the 20th anniversary of the OTPC. The Neil Hann Award honors individuals who display innovation, inspiration, and leadership in creating a culture of health in Oklahoma.



Neil E. Hann, MPH, CHES retired from the Oklahoma State Department of Health in 2017 as Assistant Deputy Commissioner for Community and Family Health Services where he assisted with the oversight of 68 county health departments and major program areas such as Maternal and Child Health (MCH) and Women Infant and Children (WIC). Prior to his last position, Mr. Hann was Director of the Community Development Service and oversaw six divisions including Turning Point - a statewide community engagement and health improvement initiative. He considers his work with Turning Point and many collaborative partners across Oklahoma as the highlight of his 34-year career.

The Neil Hann Award recognizes individuals who have made outstanding contributions to protecting and promoting the health of Oklahomans beyond his or her normal work duties. Award recipients will be selected based on demonstrated achievements in the following areas:

- **Providing leadership** by illustrating either a breadth and/or a depth of guidance instrumental to achieved outcomes in the health of Oklahomans.
- **Demonstrating a degree of innovation and creativity** to positively influence the advancement of public health in his or her respective community.
- **Inspiring collaboration** through strategic partnerships or communities of practice amongst various sectors and diverse groups to create a culture of health in Oklahoma.
